Remember, Ab is the same as G#, Bb=A#, Db=C#, Eb=D#, Gb=F#. I have used the most commonly occurring names in the chart above. Shaded chords all use the moveable shapes shown in the video, non-shaded chords are common chord shapes.

There are lots more moveable shapes like this if you get used to muting strings – try moving an **Em** or **Gm** up and down, muting the G string, for example.
